

TRAFFIC ALERT

WHAT: PALM DESERT – TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF SAN PABLO AVENUE AND MAGNESIA FALLS DRIVE STARTING JULY 14 -17

The second phase of the San Pablo Avenue streetscape improvement project is near completion. San Pablo Avenue and Magnesia Falls Drive will be closed starting on July 14 in the afternoon.

Magnesia Falls will also be closed between Monterey Avenue and the Palm Desert Aquatic Center driveway, which will remain open during this work. San Pablo will be closed between Fred Waring and Magnesia Falls. The road closures will allow for milling and placement of final asphalt concrete.

On July 16, starting at 7 am, intermittent lane closures will be necessary on Fred Waring between Civic Center Driveway (remain open) and College of the Desert Driveway. One lane in each direction will be open for traffic during the placement of the final asphalt concrete.

Access to Civic Center Park, Palm Desert City Hall, and offices in the Civic Center complex will be available via Fred Waring Drive.

Delays are possible and motorists are encouraged to allow extra time or use alternate routes such as Monterey Avenue, Fred Waring Drive or Portola Avenue.

Stage two of the project is expected to finish by mid-July 2021 following final striping.
